Gordon E. MacNair, SR/WA, AACI, P.App, is an Infrastructure Real State Consultant who specializes in right of way matters.

Up until July 2019, Gord was the Director, Corporate Real Estate Office for the City of Ottawa whose team was responsible for all real estate disciplines including acquisitions/expropriations, disposals, leasing, valuation, land management, and strategic real property initiatives for the City of Ottawa.
